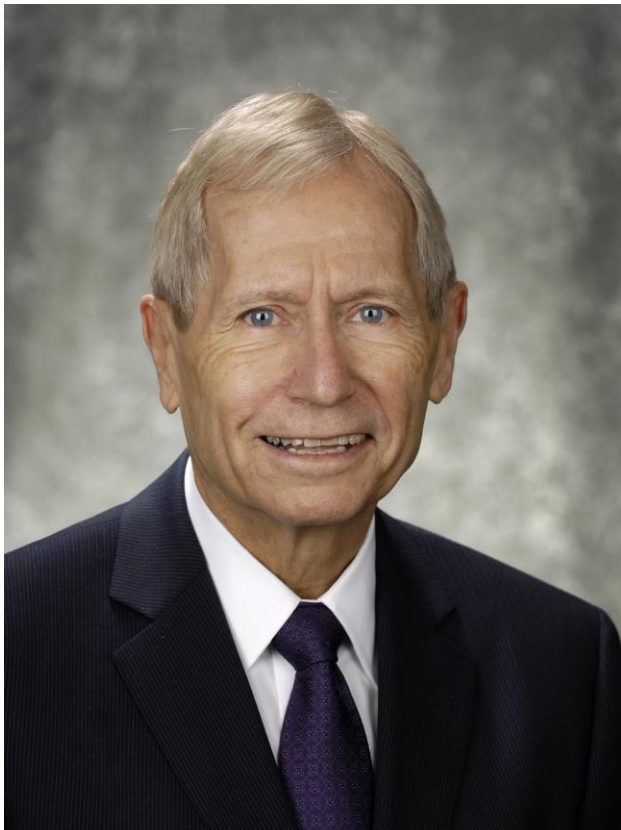


Main Street Community Center – Get to Know the Board of Directors
