

DAY 1: MEMPHIS

Upon arrival in Memphis enjoy your included lunch at the King's Palace Cafe. This afternoon we visit the Sun Studio known worldwide as "The Birthplace of Rock'n'Roll". Enjoy three nights' at an extraordinary hotel experience in the heart of Elvis Presley's Graceland. Tonight, you will have dinner at Marlowe's Ribs Restaurant, home to world-championship BBQ and loaded with Elvis memorabilia. (L,D)

DAY 2: MEMPHIS

After our delicious buffet breakfast we will have a local step-on guide and learn how the city became known as the home of the Blues and the birthplace of rock'n'roll. Also, enjoy a stop at Historic Levitt Shell (where Elvis gave his first paid concert). Pass by the world-famous St. Jude Pavilion, The Pyramid and the iconic Mississippi River. Also included is a stop at the Peabody Hotel to view the famous "March of the Peabody Ducks." After the tour you will have time for lunch on your own in downtown Memphis. This afternoon we will visit the Memphis Rock N Soul Museum. The birthplace of rock and soul music, created by the Smithsonian Institution, tells the story of musical pioneers who for the love of music, overcame racial and socio-economic barriers to create the music that shook the entire world. This evening during dinner on Beale Street at the Blues City Cafe you will be entertained by

DAY 3: MEMPHIS

You will have a classic Southern cooking delicious buffet breakfast featuring contemporary versions of the King's breakfast favorites, and of course, signature Southern biscuits in three satisfyingly savory flavors and then explore the mansion Elvis called home as well as exhibits showcasing Elvis' career, his automobiles, his wardrobe, his gold records and much more from Graceland Archives. We head to Vernon's Smokehouse for lunch which features authentic Memphis BBQ. This afternoon we visit Stax Museum of American Soul Music which is one of only a handful of museums in the world dedicated to soul music. Stax supported the careers of artists such as Otis Redding, Isaac Hayes, and many more. Enjoy dinner at the iconic Rendezvous. (B,L,D)

DAY 4: MEMPHIS-HOME

This morning we stop at the National Civil Rights Museum, a very special experience that takes visitors through centuries of history. It is an overview of the American Civil Rights Movement from slavery to the present. As you sit back and enjoy your trip home we hope you have enjoyed the best attractions in Memphis and barbecue in the world. (B)
