



Privacy Policy

Main Street Community Center (MSCC) is an Illinois-based nonprofit organization committed to protecting the privacy and security of personal information entrusted to us by community members, participants, donors, volunteers, and website visitors. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, protect, and disclose personal information in compliance with applicable Illinois law.

This Privacy Policy applies to personal information collected from:

- Illinois residents and non-residents interacting with Main Street Community Center
- Website visitors
- Program participants, parents/guardians, donors, volunteers, and staff applicants

We comply with the Illinois Personal Information Protection Act ("PIPA"), 815 ILCS 530, which applies to nonprofit organizations that collect or maintain personal information of Illinois residents.

Information We Collect

a. Personal Information You Provide

We may collect the following types of personal information when voluntarily provided:

- Full name
- Email address
- Telephone number
- Home or mailing address
- Emergency contact details
- Program registration and attendance information
- Donation and payment information
- Limited demographic information necessary for programs or reporting

"Personal information" is defined consistent with Illinois law and may include an individual's name combined with sensitive identifiers such as financial account data or medical information when required for participation.

b. Online and Automatically Collected Information

When you visit our website, we may automatically collect:

- IP address
- Browser type
- Device and operating system information

- Pages visited and duration of visits

This information is used solely for analytics, website management, and security purposes.

3. Use of Personal Information

Main Street Community Center uses personal information only for legitimate nonprofit purposes, including:

- Administering programs, classes, and events
- Communicating program updates, schedules, and community information
- Processing donations and payments
- Responding to inquiries and requests
- Maintaining compliance, records, and internal reporting
- Improving services and outreach

We do not sell, rent, or trade personal information.

4. Disclosure and Sharing of Information

We may share personal information only:

- With trusted service providers (e.g., payment processors, email platforms) who are contractually required to maintain reasonable security measures as required by Illinois law
- When required by law, court order, or legal process
- To protect the rights, safety, or property of Main Street Community Center or others

5. Data Security (Illinois PIPA Compliance)

In accordance with the Illinois Personal Information Protection Act, we implement and maintain reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards to protect personal information from unauthorized access, disclosure, or misuse.

6. Data Breach Notification (Illinois Residents)

If a breach of unsecured personal information occurs, Main Street Community Center will:

- Notify affected Illinois residents in the most expedient time possible and without unreasonable delay
- Provide information about the type of data involved and steps individuals can take to protect themselves
- Notify the Illinois Attorney General if a breach affects more than 500 Illinois residents, as required by law

7. Biometric Information (If Applicable)

Main Street Community Center does not collect biometric identifiers (such as fingerprints or facial geometry) unless explicitly disclosed.

If biometric information is ever collected, we will comply fully with the Illinois Biometric Information Privacy Act (BIPA), 740 ILCS 14, including:

- Providing written notice of the collection purpose and retention period
- Obtaining written consent prior to collection
- Maintaining a written biometric data retention and destruction policy
- Prohibiting the sale or disclosure of biometric data

8. Children's Privacy

Main Street Community Center on occasion serves children and families. Personal information about minors is collected only with parental or legal guardian consent and is used solely for program participation, safety, and compliance purposes.

We do not knowingly collect children's personal information for marketing or commercial use.

9. Your Illinois Privacy Rights

Illinois residents may:

- Request access to their personal information
- Request correction of inaccurate information
- Request deletion of information, where legally permissible
- Opt out of non-essential communications

10. Cookies and Website Technologies

Our website may use cookies to improve functionality and performance. You may disable cookies through your browser settings; however, certain features may not function properly.

11. Changes to This Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy periodically to reflect changes in law or operations. Updates will be posted with a revised effective date. Continued use of our services constitutes acceptance of the updated policy.
